BEST SCHOOL DELEGATION

Best delegation is the most prestigious and coveted award at SPARK MUN, presented to the one institution whose delegates have shown professional finesse in the tasks required of them in their respective committees. Their performance shall be marked upon by the Executive Boards of respective committees through their level of participation and the awards received in each committee, which itself is a judgement criteria for the best delegation award.





CRITERIA

Criteria for Judgement of Committee Awards:

- Eloquence : The speech presented by the delegate must reflect in- depth understanding of the agenda and their country's stance on the same.
- Discipline : Professionalism, respect towards the Executive Board and fellow delegates. No slang or foul language shall be entertained and strict action will be taken against delegates found erring in this regard.
- Contribution to the conference : Initiating discussions and representation of their country, quality of position papers and resolutions and posing interjections.
- Accuracy of the content presented : Reliable sources of reference and usage of relevant facts and statistics to support the point presented.

Eligibility and Judgement criteria for the Best School Delegation Award

The participants from individual institutions must represent one or more portfolios in a minimum of FOUR out of SEVEN Committees to be eligible for this award. Each delegation fulfilling the above criteria shall be given one point with a maximum of 8 points. Further points shall be granted to the delegations depending upon the type and the number of awards the delegates of a particular institution win (with respect to its delegation size) which again shall be awarded by the Executive Board members with their fine skills of judgement.

STEP 2: Refer to the country matrix and choose your committee and portfolio.

STEP 3: Verify your details prior to submission and submit your form.

STEP 4: Once your registration form has been received, an confirmation email will be sent to you, stating payment procedure. The Registration Fee is Rs. 1300/-. **After payment, you are required to mail a screenshot of the payment.**

STEP 5: The payment must be made within 24 hours of receiving the first confirmation mail. Once the payment has been received and all the formalities are fulfilled, a final email will be sent to you by 10 days stating your committee and portfolio
