About Our Institution

Fr. Agnel Sr. Sec. This society is renowned for running highly reputed educational institutions across India, including branches in Mumbai, Noida, Pune, Greater Noida, Vaishali, and Delhi, all recognized for their excellence, efficiency, and dedication.

The Delhi branch, established in 1979, currently has an enrollment of around 2,850 students. Criteria for Judgement of Committee

Awards:

Eloquence: The delegate's speech must demonstrate a deep understanding of the agenda and accurately represent their assigned country's stance.

Discipline: Delegates are expected to maintain professionalism and show respect towards the Executive Board and fellow delegates at all times. Use of slang or foul language is strictly prohibited, and any violations will invite disciplinary action.

Contribution to the Conference:

Active participation in debates and discussions, strong representation of their country's policies, and submission of high-quality position papers and resolutions. Constructive interjections and points of information.

Accuracy of Content Presented:

Arguments must be supported by reliable and credible sources. Usage of relevant facts, figures, and statistics is essential to substantiate points made during debate.



Best School Delegation:

Best Delegation Award – SPARK MUN

The Best Delegation Award at SPARK MUN is a prestigious honour presented to the institution whose delegation consistently exemplifies excellence, professionalism, and diplomatic acumen across all committees. This award is not merely a reflection of individual brilliance, but a collective testament to teamwork, preparation, and commitment to the spirit of Model United Nations. Delegates representing the institution will be closely observed and evaluated by the Executive Boards of their respective committees on several parameters. These include the quality and consistency of participation in debates, ability to engage in constructive dialogue, submission of well-researched position papers and resolutions, and their demonstration of leadership, negotiation, and problem-solving skills during sessions. A key criterion for this award is the number and nature of awards secured by the institution's delegates across various committees. The cumulative performance of the delegation marked by decorum, diplomacy, and strategic engagement will determine which institution earns the title of Best Delegation at SPARK MUN.



Criteria



Eligibility and Judgement Criteria for the Best School Delegation Award:

- The participants from individual institutions must represent one or more portfolios in a minimum of FOUR out of SEVEN Committees to be eligible for this award.
- Each delegation fulfilling the above criteria shall be given one point, with a maximum of 8 points.
- Further points shall be granted to the delegations depending upon the type and the number of awards the delegates of a particular institution win (with respect to its delegation size), which again shall be awarded by the Executive Board members with their fine skills of judgement.

STEP 2: Refer to the **Country Matrix** and choose your committee and portfolio.

STEP 3: Verify your details prior to submission and submit your form.

STEP 4: Once your registration form has been received, a confirmation email will be sent to you, stating the payment procedure. The Registration Fee is Rs. 1800/-. After payment, you are required to mail a screenshot of the payment.

STEP 5: The payment must be made within 48 hours of receiving the first confirmation email. Once the payment has been received and all the formalities are fulfilled, a final email will be sent to you within 5 days stating your committee and portfolio.
