NOTICE

Dear Parents,

Since time is of essence, and students are awaiting their Board results which may be announced at the end of June 2021, the School has allotted streams for the prospective Class XI of 2021-22, based on the average of the scores of Class IX, and the two Pre-Boards of 2020-21. Effort has been made to allot as per the student's first preference, provided his or her average matches the 'inter se' merit scores. Teaching in Class XI will begin in earnest, as the per the given schedule, from day one.

These allotments are final, and all requests have been considered, factoring the norms that have been stated here above. This is a standard and a non-negotiable regulation in our school; the stream allotted to a student, after due process is not to be changed after the Board results. The admission is finalized on payment of fees and joining the Class.

No mainstream subject can be allotted as the 6th subject, as per school norms. Students are required to join the Section allotted from day one. At the end of the first week all absentee students will be struck off the rolls and will clearly forfeit the right for the stream as it will be given to those next in the merit list and who attend regularly throughout the month of June. Absence from classes in the month of June, will be considered as a decision by the absentee student, to leave school and all such absentee students will be deemed to have left school and their names struck off the rolls.

If per chance, any clarification is to be sought by anyone, the same may be done, through an email communication to agnellenquiry11@gmail.com by 26th May 2021(10:00am). The School will revert to you and respond by 29th May 2021 (06:00pm), only if a change is possible.

(This process prevents endless enquiries that seek to bypass the process followed and becomes a drain on the time of the School Management and the Faculty and deprives students who have joined the class, undue days, as classes have to on stream from day one).
