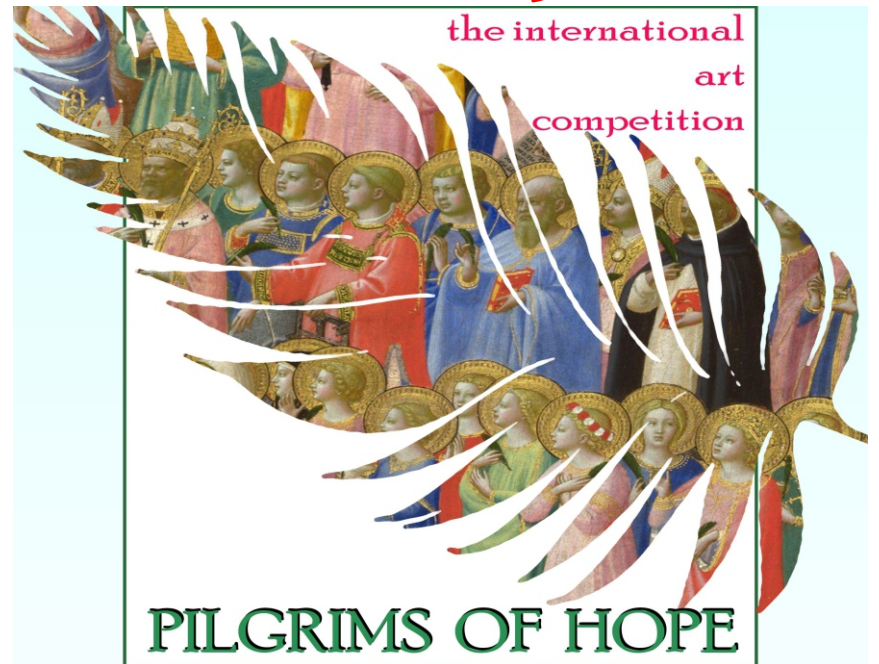


INTERNATIONAL ART COMPETITION "WITNESSES OF HOPE" on the occasion of the JUBILEE YEAR 2025



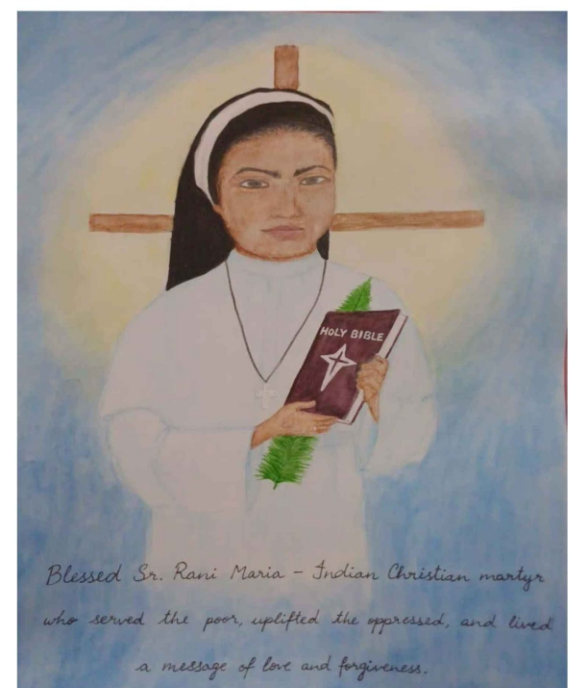
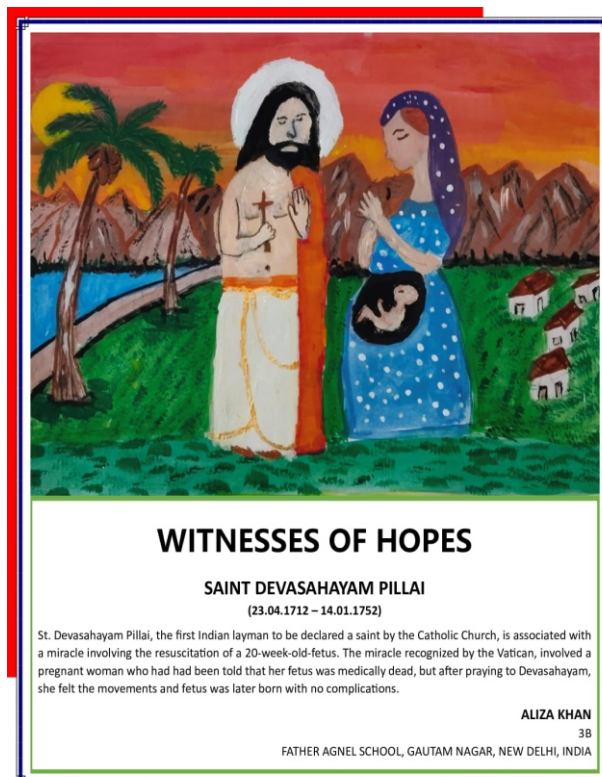

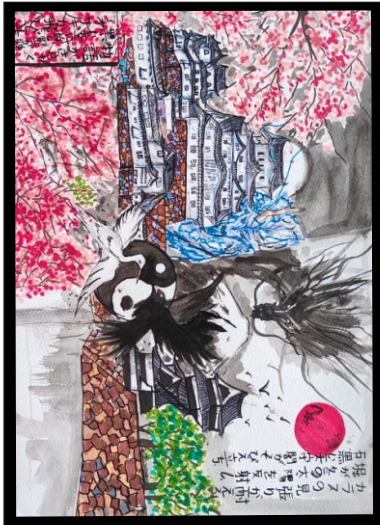


Japan On Canvas
